SweetSpot Group organise cycling's Tour of Britain, the UK's biggest and most prestigious bike race. Taking place over eight days in September, it attracts some of the world's top cyclists and is shown live in 190 countries worldwide.

Last Friday it was in our county – Warwickshire – and we are really proud to support it with our promotional staff, who are booked through SweetSpot.

SweetSpot are cycling specialists and formed the Tour in 2004 to revive the event that had only been run twice in the previous decade. This is one of the events SweetSpot organise throughout the year. Grace said: "I started using Envisage in 2015; we use them for the hospitality tent – so they do bar work and waiting. On the blgger days we use an Envisage Event Manager and hospitality staff, so for this year's final stage in Manchester we used a team of eight staff.
